1. Introduction

4. Duration of data management. Storage of personal data

We store the personal data you have provided only for the period required to fulfill each of the specified purposes. More specifically:

- Personal data related to user registration in the 10th Global Ham Congress: We store
 registration data for the duration of the congress. Once the congress has finalized, we
 will store your data only for as long as is strictly necessary to comply with applicable
 legal requirements.
- Data on user browsing habits on the Website: IFEMA will store the data collected through the use of cookies, in accordance with the terms specified above, for the period of one year. When you visit the Website after one year has passed, you will again be asked to give your consent to the use of cookies.

5. International communication and transfer of personal data

We do not share your personal data with third parties, with the exception of data required by our suppliers for congress management. The only other instance in which we may share personal data is when required to comply with legal, judicial or administrative requirements, or under subpoena from State Security Forces and Law Enforcement.

We make no international transfers of data to countries outside of the European Economic Area (EEA), where personal data protection may not be equivalent to the protection provided by the Data Protection Act.

6. Data protection rights
